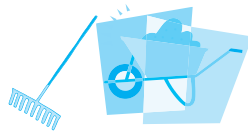
St. Lucy Parish School Committee

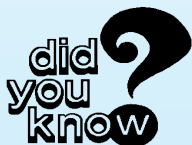
