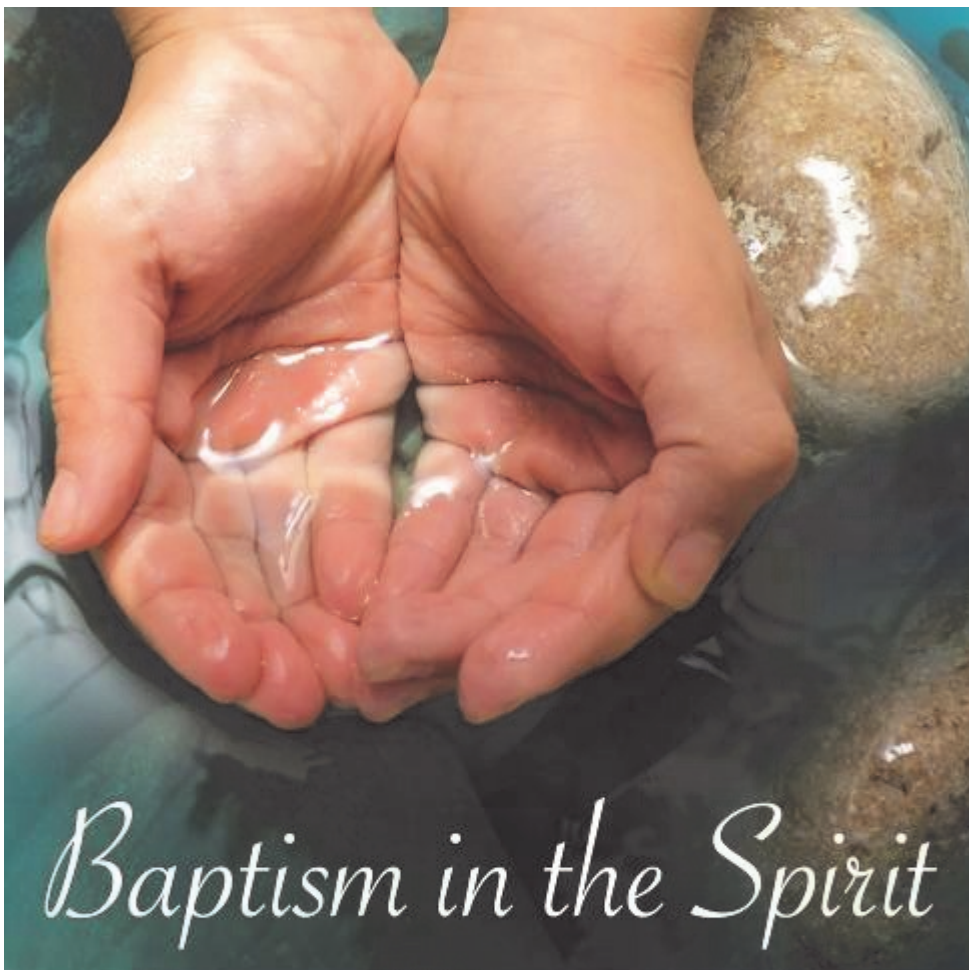

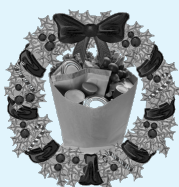
I would like to first thank all who participated in our Priesthood Sunday - it was a great gathering with fantastic food. The cards and remembrances were humbling. Thank You!!!

In an effort to save a substantial amount of expense (almost \$2000 annually) on our contribution envelopes, we will be switching to what is called a dollar size envelope beginning this January 2012. We currently use the mailback style which you can stamp and put right in the mail. The dollar size is slightly smaller and must be placed in another envelope. Most Parishes use this size so the envelope company can offer a substantial discount to St. Lucy.

Most of you do not mail them so this change will not affect you. For those of you who do, please remember to place it in a regular envelope. We are sorry for any inconvenience this may cause but at a \$2000 savings, we could not justify keeping the current style. Thank you.
