Thanks to all of you we can continue to pray in comfort and park our cars on a parking lot that is secure in its foundation. Also, thanks for your patience and support during the necessary repairs - I know it was inconvenient but well worth it!!! The total cost of the air conditioner repair is \$15,513. The parking lot repairs amount to \$130,000. Our parking lot project had an estimated cost of about \$100,000.00 but with the discovery of concrete blocks, slag and other old items under ground - along with repairing another 15 feet of the parking lot - our cost increased much more than expected. The total cost of our two projects is \$145,513.00. Because of your generous participation in our second collection, we collected \$16,660.00 which will help to cover our total cost. Two families came forward with very generous donations that aided in our collection of the \$16,660.00 - they are examples of the special place our parish holds on their heart. Our parish remains a strong presence in the world because of your participation!!

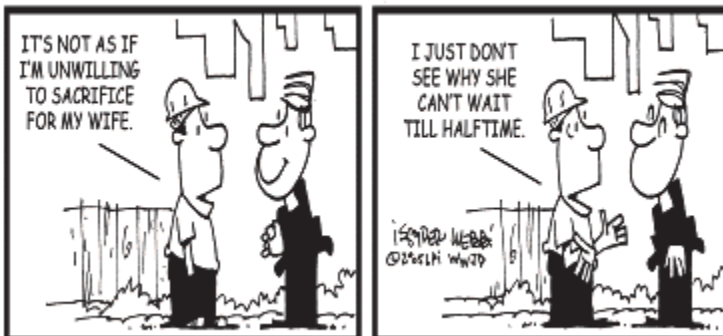
