## Changing light bulbs at St. Lucy's.

It only takes one guy to change a light bulb, but it takes a group effort to get the job done. The door closers need to be taken off to widen the openings to get the lift through. Pews need to be moved out of the way. The lift needs to be repositioned to reach all areas.



It costs approximately \$2600.00 to change the light bulbs.. Since it is so expensive, we try to do it only once a year or so.

We replaced a few ceiling tiles in areas that could be reached. Might as well do a few jobs as long as we got someone up there!

We will need to use a different lift to reach the ceiling tiles that are above the altar close to the bell tower.
